ACTIVITIES	<p>Providing Access to Water</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Build rain harvesting systems • Repair and protect springs, construct wells • Install piped water extension projects <hr/> <p>Improving Hygiene and Sanitation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conduct WASH trainings on hygiene and sanitation • Build latrines, handwashing stations, dish racks and other household hygiene necessities <hr/> <p>Creating Food Security</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide improved seed varieties of household consumables (fruits and vegetables) • Conduct training on household nutrition and care <hr/> <p>Providing Access to Health</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Organize door-step health clinics for testing, treatment, and referrals • Conduct health trainings on prenatal care, family planning, and preventative healthcare • Provide bike ambulances for remote access 	<p>Maximizing Income from Current Sources</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide improved agricultural inputs for crop diversification and higher yield • Conduct agricultural trainings on organics, pre and post harvest management and care • Provide access to farming tools <hr/> <p>Generating New Income Streams and Building Productive Assets</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide livestock inputs and conduct livestock management and care training • Initiate community-led income generating projects • Optimize household farm productivity, and encourage external household income <hr/> <p>Building Financial Empowerment</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Establish Village Savings and Loan Associations (VSLA) • Provide peer-reviewed, local access to credit • Offer Healthy Household Training including gender equity sensitization, conflict resolution and financial literacy skills 	<p>Developing Leadership Skills</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Establish community leadership committees ensuring women and youth participation. • Conduct leadership training and provide ongoing mentorship • Train Community Agricultural Teams (CAT) and Village Livestock Teams (VLT) <hr/> <p>Improving Access to Markets</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Establish pathways for regional development by connecting communities within clusters • Provide tools and means for community to access roads and construct pathways <hr/> <p>Providing Follow-up and Ongoing Support</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conduct village performance reviews • Provide ongoing support and capacity building for agriculture, livestock, water, WASH, VSLA and community-driven initiatives • Address risks and issues to support communities managing projects independently • Ensure readiness for graduation
