REMOVE SCARCITY BARRIERS

Providing Access to Water

- Build rain harvesting systems
- Repair and protect springs, construct wells
- Install piped water extension projects

Improving Hygiene and Sanitation

- Conduct WASH trainings on hygiene and sanitation
- Build latrines, handwashing stations, dish racks and other household hygiene necessities

Creating Food Security

- Provide improved seed varieties of household consumables (fruits and vegetables)
- Conduct training on household nutrition and care

Providing Access to Health

- Organize door-step health clinics for testing, treatment, and referrals
- Conduct health trainings on prenatal care, family planning, and preventative healthcare
- Provide bike ambulances for remote access

Time and Space

- Increased productivity due to access to water and health
- Improved household health determinants
- Reduced health and safety risks for women and children
- Inclusive community development and broad participation in training and activities by eliminating key constraints
